In consideration to paying spectators, no cats may be removed from the show hall before the end of the advertised show hours without the Show Manager's permission.

Strictly no flash photography in the show hall.

Benching

The club will provide double spaces (2ft 2 inches x 4ft x 2ft). Owners may supply their own pen or hire both single and double pens. 2 cats or 3 kittens may share a double pen.

Benching will be in row format. Requests for benching preferences should be submitted with entry; these cannot be guaranteed, however every effort will be made. Special litterbins will be provided and exhibitors are required to bag any cat waste before disposal to reduce the possibility of cross infection to members of the public and each other. Exhibitors should bring their own litter trays, litter, water and cat food.

Health Requirements

This is a vetted show, the vets in attendance will be Animedics of Taunton. Cats showing signs of illness, mites, fleas or fungal infection will not be permitted into the show hall. All cats should be in date for vaccinations with Feline Enteritis and Cat Flu - records should be produced at vetting in. Cats from households where there has been an infectious disease or fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws front and back must be clipped.

Transport

The nearest train station is Taunton, which is on the First Great Western line. Nearest Airports are Bristol International and Exeter. Heathrow and Gatwick are also accessible.

The nearest airport operating the PETS system is London Heathrow. The club cannot offer transport.

Clerking/assistance: If you would like to help our clerks and stewards at the show, please contact either the show manager or the entry clerk.

Kittens: Kittens entered in the show must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 months of age on the day of the show. Altered kittens are eligible for entry. Household pets over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered.

Registration: With the exception of New Traits and New Breeds, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete for a cat's first show, but is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional and International awards.
